

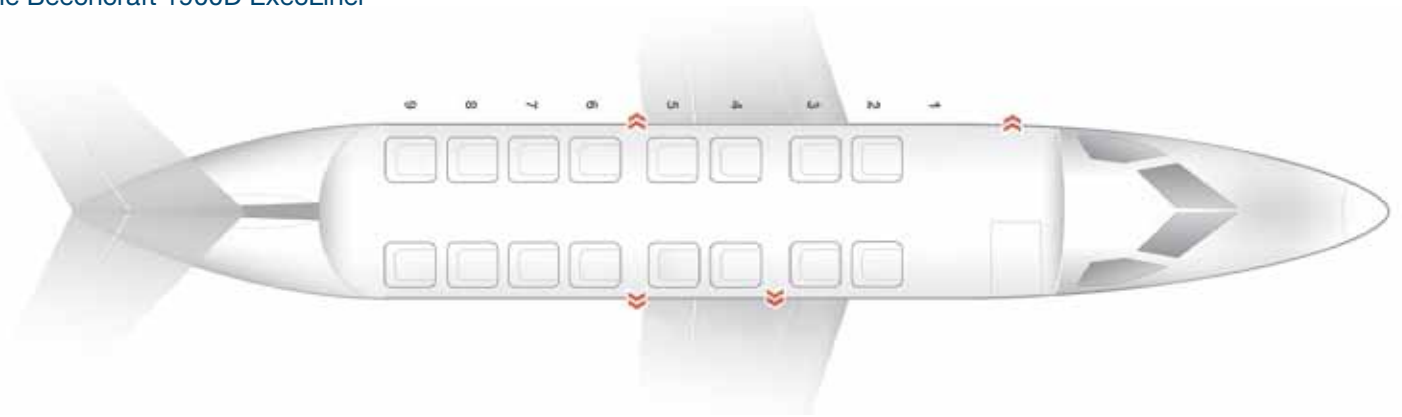

DAY 06 **FRI** **SAN FRANCISCO**
 – 17-MILE DRIVE – MONTEREY
 – CALIFORNIA'S CENTRAL COAST

Heading south this morning via motorcoach you'll embark on an exhilarating journey along one of the most scenic roads in the world, 17-Mile Drive. Hugging the Pacific coastline while passing emerald green fairways and stunning estates, this coastal landmark runs through Pacific Grove to Pebble Beach. Afterward, take in the sights, sounds and smells of Monterey at Old Fisherman's Wharf in downtown and explore Cannery Row's historic waterfront district, John Steinbeck's inspiration for his novel of the same name. Continuing south, Pacific Coast Highway's twisting, cliff-hugging route takes you through the quaint village of Carmel-by-the-Sea and Big Sur where mountains plunge into the Pacific Ocean. Further south, the landscape mellows to oak-studded hills as the highway passes Hearst Castle and Morro Bay. From here, a short distance inland is San Luis Obispo and the heart of California's Central Coast.
